Brintons Recommendations

Planning for Care and Maintenance: It is important to instigate, from day one, a well planned care and maintenance programme identifying the different types of traffic areas in the installation matching their requirements with regular, planned cleaning and maintenance procedures.

Each area of the installation will require an individual maintenance plan developed according to traffic patterns and soiling rates. These plans should be based upon formal site audits with layouts, traffic flows and traffic level predictions all being taken into consideration. (source: Brintons Cleaning and Maintenance Guidelines)

Interim Cleaning: Absorbent powder compound is a very effective dry carpet cleaning system. The compound is made up of a particle moistened with a water/detergent/solvent emulsion. Its purpose is to break down and absorb particles of soil from the carpet pile. The absorbent powder compound is sprinkled evenly over the carpet and brushed in using a special counter rotating brush machine. The brushes help to lift the pile and restore surface appearance as well cleaning the fibres.

After the powder has dried (approximately 1/2 hour) it should be removed from the pile of the carpet using a powerful upright vacuum cleaner. Absorbent powder cleaning has the advantage that only the badly soiled areas of the carpet need be cleaned. (source: Brintons Cleaning and Maintenance Guidelines)

Hot Water Extraction: The hot water extraction tank is filled with a diluted fibre conditioner without shampoo. A pre-spray solution is then applied to the carpet using a power spray with a fine spray nozzle. The chemical is left for a few minutes in order for the chemicals to work and the carpet is then treated with the hot water extraction machine filled with the fibre conditioner rinse. This flushes the pre-spray from the carpet leaving the fibres in a very clean condition, less likely to attract further soiling. It is extremely important, whichever system is employed, that the carpet is not allowed to become over wet, otherwise shrinkage can occur. (source: Brintons Cleaning and Maintenance Guidelines)

Key Points to Remember: Only products suitable for use on wool rich carpets should be used, this also applies to our 100% nylon carpets. Suitable products are listed on the "WOOLSAFE" website at www.woolsafe.org.

It is very important that the carpet is not allowed to become over wet during hot water extraction or any other cleaning process as shrinkage may occur.(source: Brintons Cleaning and Maintenance Guidelines)
