

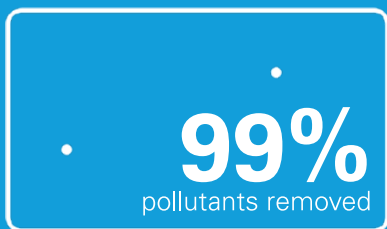
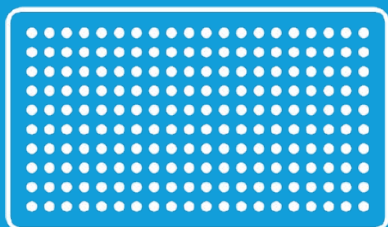

milliCare's Dry Polymer System

Not all cleaning methods are created equal. Water-based cleaning methods slowly break down carpet and textile fibers and leave soapy residues that contribute to the buildup of dirt, allergens and other harmful particles. milliCare's dry, nontoxic cleaning system goes deep inside your carpet to remove dirt and up to 99% of pollutants and harmful VOCs (Volatile Organic Compounds) when used with a properly functioning HVAC.

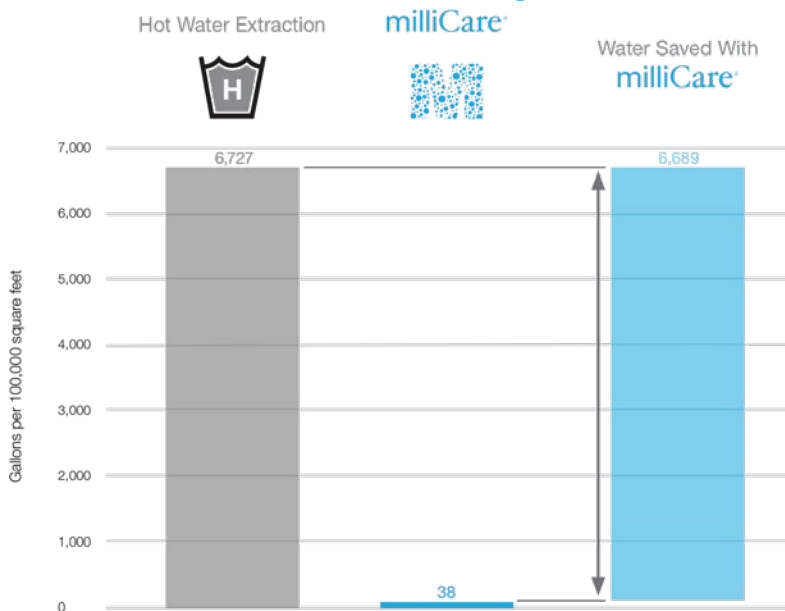

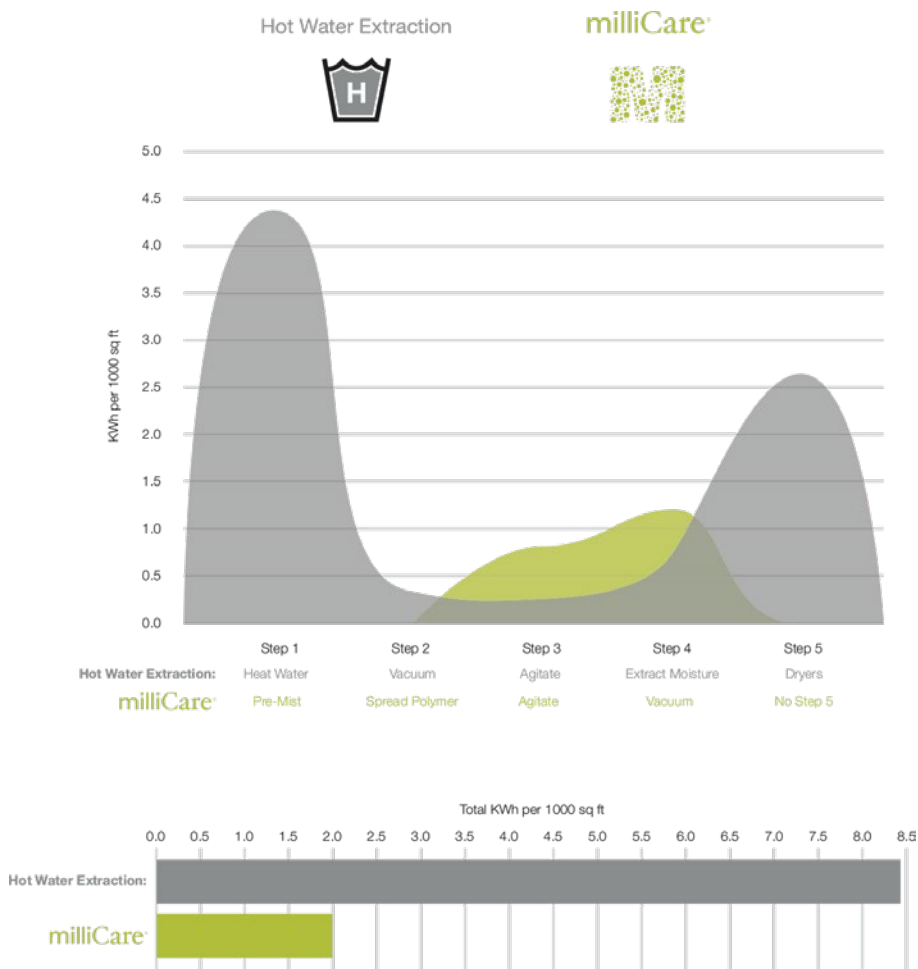
